CREATE A SAFE ENVIRONMENT

ESTABLISH ROUTINES

ESTABLISH EASY TRANSITIONS

Transitions are part of every classroom as one activity ends and another activity begins. What routines teachers and students establish during transition times can make for a quiet and peaceful looking classroom.





USE SILENT CUES

When students begin to find themselves distracted by other materials and lose focus, teachers can use silent cues to bring the students back to focusing on the lesson on hand.

HARNESS YOUR INTUITION

Teachers who are aware of their students actions, behaviors, and emotions are ones who use their intuition to help keep students active and participating in the class instead of losing focus.
